Tara R. Palacios is the *Director of BizLaunch*, Arlington's Small Business and Entrepreneurial Assistance Network in Arlington County, Virginia. Ms. Palacios initiated the BizLaunch program in 2002 to help entrepreneurs successfully grow and expand their businesses in the County. Since its inception the program has outreached to over 50,000 business owners through sponsored workshops, seminars, and one-on-one counseling sessions. Ms. Palacios has over 20 years of experience in Marketing and Business Development at a variety of firms: a health maintenance organization, an IT software developer, a financial institution, and a uranium enricher before joining Arlington County in 2001.

In 2004 she received Arlington's Best Business Award (ABBIES) for her steadfast contribution to the small business community. She also received the 2005 Small Business Advocate Award by the Arlington Small Business Development

Center (SBDC). Ms. Palacios was awarded the 2010 District Director Award and the 2006 Minority Small Business Champion of the Year by the U.S. Small Business Administration. She was also honored as a Person of Vision by Arlington County's Commission on the Status of Women in 2009. Ms. Palacios was awarded the Northern Virginia Black Chamber of Commerce 2013 Outstanding Public Partner Award, and the 2013 Entrepreneurship Partner Award by the Business Development Assistance Group (BDAG). In 2017, Ms. Palacios was inducted as an honorary SCORE member, and in 2018 received the Commonwealth of Virginia's Partnership Award for her work with state and fostering entrepreneurship. In May Ms. Palacios will receive the 2019 Director's Partnership Award from the Washington Metropolitan Area District Office of the U.S. Small Business Administration.

From the Baltimore area:

Take I-95 South to I-495 (Capitol Beltway) and follow sign 495 West towards Silver Spring. Continue on 495 past the Maryland exits into Northern Virginia to Exit 47A (Route 7 West -Leesburg Pike).

Merge onto Route 7 West (Leesburg Pike toward Tysons Corner).

Turn right onto Towers Crescent Drive. Our office building is on the left across from the Marriott. Go past our office building and take a left onto Shoptysons Blvd. Make the second left into the parking garage. Take a parking ticket and proceed through the gate, take a hard left, then a hard right and proceed straight to the second gate. Visitors will use the key pad located at the second gate to dial 02 for Venable; reception will open the gate.

or

Turn right onto Fashion Blvd.

Proceed straight through the three-way stop sign and then proceed straight through one traffic light. Make a right into the parking garage for Towers Crescent Parking. Take a parking ticket and follow the signs for 8010. Visitors will use the key pad located at the second gate to dial 02 for Venable; reception will open the gate.

The gates will automatically raise from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. to allow visitors to park on the P1 level outside of reception hours.

Park on the P-1 level.

Enter the 8010 elevator lobby and proceed to the third-floor reception.

From the Washington, D.C. area:

Take I-66 to Exit #66B (Route 7 W/ Leesburg Pike).

Merge onto Route 7 West (Leesburg Pike toward Tysons Corner).

Turn right onto Towers Crescent Drive. Our building is on the left across from the Marriott. Go past our office building and take a left onto Shop Tysons Blvd. Make the second left into the parking garage. Take a parking ticket and proceed through the gate, take a hard left, then a hard right and proceed straight to the second gate. Visitors will use the key pad located at the second gate to dial 02 for Venable; reception will open the gate.

or

Turn right onto Fashion Blvd.

Proceed straight through the three-way stop sign and then proceed straight through one traffic light. Make a right into the parking garage for Towers Crescent Parking. Take a parking ticket and follow the signs for 8010. Visitors will use the key pad located at the second gate to dial 02 for Venable; reception will open the gate.

Parking:

Parking is available in various areas of the parking garage. Visitors are encouraged to park on the P1 level of the parking garage to gain direct access to our building. Parking is validated at reception.



You can enter the Towers Crescent parking garage through the entrances marked #1, #2 or #3. Take a ticket (validation tickets are provided at reception) at the gate and follow the signs for 8010. Visitors will use the key pad located at the second gate to dial 02 for Venable; reception will open the gate. The gates will automatically raise from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. to allow visitors to park on the P1 level outside of reception hours. Park on the P-1 level. Enter the 8010 lobby and proceed to the third-floor reception.

Metro:

Take Metro's Silver Line to the Tysons Corner Station. From the metro station: Head West Turn left toward Tysons One Place Turn left onto Tysons One Place Turn right onto Towers Crescent Drive Turn right onto Towers Crescent Plaza 8010 Towers Crescent Plaza Total walking distance is 0.8 miles, taking approximately 17 minutes.
